1st. Mrs L Parker's Draxpark Five Star Review A well balanced baby of pleasing size for 5 months. Feminine head with everything correct. She has a strong front assembly with good depth of chest. Strong level topline, good bone with balanced angulation front and rear. Moved well with good length of stride and confidence.

Minor Puppy Dog (1,0)

1st. Ms G Willetts Philoma The Professional Loved this 8 month old young man. Excellent outline with masculine head, so typical of the breed. Great shoulder lines with good depth and strength of body. Well angulated throughout. He was unsettled on the move but this should tighten with age. Well presented black jacket with texture in coat and furnishings. Pushed for reserve challenge certificate,

Junior Dog (2,1)

1st. Mrs A & Miss A Lowood-Price Adreana Jagermeister 14 months Excellent head, he uses his ears well to aid typical expression, good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Ribs and loin of good length with strong topline that held when moving. He moves with reach and drive in profile action but close when moving away. Presented in short, harsh, black jacket.

Novice Dog (1,0)

1st. Ms. D Urbanowska's Snakesbury Gibbs 18 months A square male of good size with a pleasing correct head, he uses his ears well when alert. Strong back and loin but would prefer more depth of chest. Correct harsh jacket and furnishings. He came together when moving in profile.

Graduate Dog (0,0)

Post Graduate Dog (1,0)

1st. Mrs L Parker's Draxpark Face The Chaser 17 month old black male. He has a strong, balanced front assembly, correct shoulder placement with visible forechest, not just hair. Pleasing head, level planes with dark expressive eyes, he adds to this when using his ears. Body has depth and width throughout with strong loin. Rear angulation in balance with front assembly this leads to correct driving movement. Presented in excellent, harsh jacket and furnishings. RDCC

1st. Mrs, Mr & Mrs E K & S, Descere, Desceras & Pearce Stablemaster's Twist (Imp Fin) 2 ½ year upstanding male with a stunning head in all areas. Well placed shoulders and correct front quarters. Strong body, slightly sloping topline, well set tail. Well presented with a harsh black jacket. His hind quarters have strength and correctly balanced to front leading to true driving movement viewed in all directions. DCC

Minor Puppy Bitch (1,0)

1st. Mrs L Ashworth's Sibberings Wicket Maiden 6 month puppy of good size with a lovely outline, so typical of the breed. Correct, elegant head and neck, well placed shoulders. She has depth of chest and body with forechest. Super black jacket and typical furnishings. She still needs to settle when on the move around the ring but moved well in profile.

Puppy Bitch (0,0)

Junior Bitch (2,0)

1st. Mrs A & Miss A Lowood-Price Adreana Forever Golden 14 month old balanced bitch. Pleasing head with correct planes, dark eye. Correct shoulder placement and front with depth and forechest, this depth carries through her body. Strong topline, which held on the move, and correct tail set. Well angulated rear quarters. Black jacket with harsh furnishings. Best mover of the class.

2nd. Messrs.J&G Velhinho & Donley's Echodream Sunlight 13 months black bitch with a strong body and harsh jacket. A well developed head of correct proportions and good layback of shoulder. She has depth of rib and short coupled loin but I would prefer more forechest. Moved well in profile.

Post Graduate Bitch (2,0)

1st. Mrs A & Miss A Lowood-Price's Adreana Smokin Hot 2 year old full of type, she has a beautiful feminine head, good reach of neck and correctly placed shoulders. Front and hind angulation are balanced and she moves with free easy strides holding her topline.

2nd. Ms & MR S & K Cox & Bowman's Zarina vom Schloss Ehrenberg to Grovelea (Imp Deu) 2 years 5 months Longer cast than 1st. Head of good length with parallel planes, neat well carried ears and dark eye. Shoulders are well placed but I would prefer more forechest. Good length of rib with well set tail and very good width through body. She moved close behind today with loose topline. Harsh black jacket with well placed markings.

Limit Bitch (2,1)

1st. Mrs L Parker's Draxpark Celebrity Chase 17 months bitch of good type. She has a feminine head with correct proportions, good length of neck and well placed shoulders. Good depth and width throughout with well balanced front and rear angulation. Moves with a lovely driving action in profile. Excellent black coat and furnishings.

Open Bitch (2,1)

1st. Mrs L Parker's Draxpark Crown Jewel 20 months The first thing I wrote in my notes was 'great'. A young bitch of excellent quality and type. She has a feminine head in balance to her body. Good length of neck into shoulder. Excellent, visible forechest with width across and through her body. Her length of rib and short loin give her body strength. Presented in excellent black coat with harsh furnishings. She moved with true driving action in all directions. Delighted to award her BCC and BOB

Champion Bitch (1,0)

1st. Mr & Mrs C & J Clay's CH Philoma Lucia 3 years 10 months A strong bitch with correct head, pleasing dark eye and typical schnauzer expression. Elegant neck flows into well placed shoulder. She has good depth of rib but I would prefer more forechest. Strong topline and well set tail. She stands naturally showing well made hind quarters. Shown in RBCC
